The number of people who have died in the UK after contracting coronavirus has increased by 119 to 584 in 24 hours. (Thursday 26th March 2020, 19:15). The number of people that have tested negative stands at 93,208.

UK coronavirus numbers as it stands **England** - 521 deaths, **Scotland** – 25 deaths, **Wales** – 28 deaths and **Northern Ireland** – 10 deaths.

The prime minister and chancellor led the nation in saluting NHS workers battling the coronavirus pandemic.
